



South Australia State Stimulus Measures (as of 30.03.2020)

1. The SA state government will provide a \$350 million stimulus package, with more details for how this benefits individual businesses to be announced.
2. Businesses with annual grouped wages of up to \$4 million will receive a six-month payroll tax waiver. Eligible business groups will not be required to pay any payroll tax for the months of April to September 2020 (for the return periods of March 2020 to August 2020).
