

Queensland State Stimulus Measures (as of 30.03.2020)

1. For small and medium businesses and large businesses specifically impacted by COVID-19, the QLD state government will refund two months' worth of payroll tax.
2. Small and medium businesses can receive a three-month payroll tax holiday and a further six-month payroll tax deferral, meaning that any QLD business impacted by COVID-19 will not need to make a payroll tax payment this year.
3. A package of up to \$500 million will provide assist workers who lose their job or income and to help them find jobs in the industries that are vital to getting us through this crisis including health care, agriculture, food production, transport, cleaning and mining.
4. Rent relief for businesses who rent premises from the QLD state government, as well as a provision for sole traders, small and medium businesses to receive a \$500 rebate on their power bill for this year.
