

Western Australia State Stimulus Measures (as of 30.03.2020)

1. The WA state government will provide \$114 million worth of stimulus measures to support small businesses, including a one-off payment of \$17,500 to small businesses that pay payroll tax.
2. The WA Government has also allowed business impacted by the pandemic to defer their payroll tax payments until 21 July 2020.
