

Diversity Fellowship Program

Diversity is one of Foley's core value. We believe a diverse and inclusive workforce enriches the firm's culture, encourages the sharing of ideas and experiences, and generates unique and innovative legal solutions positioning us to meet the sophisticated needs of our clients.

In 1998, Foley took the lead in strengthening the pipeline of diverse legal talent by establishing a Diversity Scholarship Program, which supported first-year law students with \$5,000 scholarships. During the tenure of this program, we awarded more than \$500,000 in scholarships to over 100 outstanding law students.

Today, we are pleased to continue this long-standing commitment with our **Diversity Fellowship Program** for second-year law students.

These fellowships are for students who share our values and demonstrate a commitment to promoting diversity and inclusion. Each Diversity Fellow receives a weekly salary throughout the 10-week program, plus a \$20,000 fellowship, which will be paid in two equal amounts: \$10,000 following successful completion of the 2022 Summer Associate Program, and \$10,000 paid within 30 days after joining the firm as an associate/law graduate.*

As you consider the opportunities that await you as a 2L, we hope you will consider Foley – and our Diversity Fellowship Program.

Eligibility

Applications will be accepted from second-year J.D. students (Class of 2023) enrolled in an ABA-accredited law school, regardless of race, gender, age, ethnicity, sexual orientation, disability, or any other characteristic or condition protected by applicable law.

- A personal statement describing your background, accomplishments, or leadership experience that would help you contribute to our diversity mission/promoting diversity at our law firm and within the community. Please limit your response to approximately 500 words.

Applications will be evaluated by the firm's Diversity Fellowship Committee on a rolling bases through **September 6, 2021**.
